- An eDay is a day in which students receive their classroom instruction electronically or traditionally in advance. These days require students to work at home and will not require physical attendance in school buildings. eDay instruction is linked to grade level standards, is real-time learning and linked to in-class learning. It should reflect work assigned during a regular school day and is a valuable day of instruction.

Why eDays?

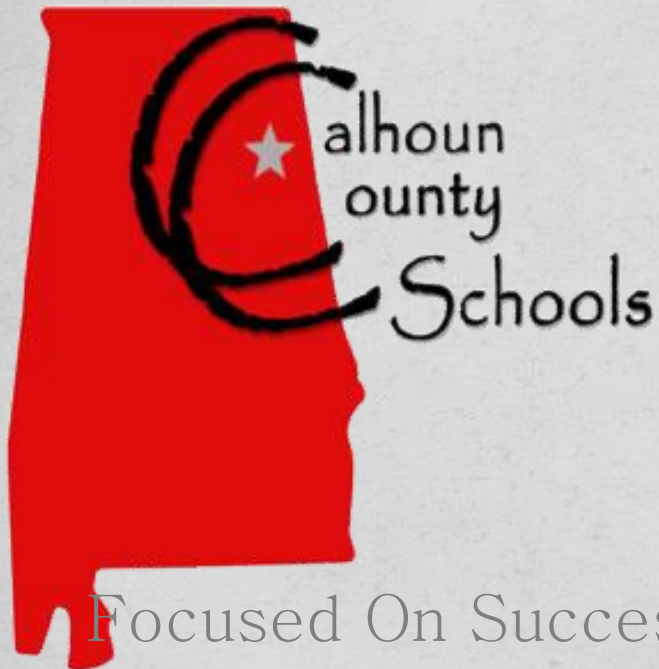




More about eDay?

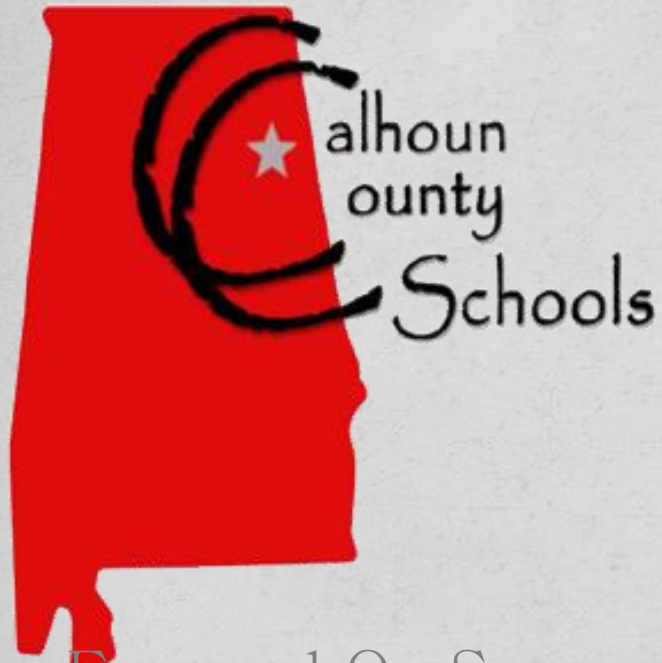
Benefits of eDays:
