- **▶** Be a U.S. citizen
- ▶ Be between the ages of 17 and 28
- ▶ Have a high school CGPA of at least 3.0 or higher (can be waived)
- ▶ Have a *High School Diploma* or GED equivalent and be enrolled at one of our colleges that offers ROTC.
- ▶ Scored minimum of 1020 on the SAT (math/verbal) or 22 on the ACT (excluding the required writing test score) **Can be waived
- ▶ Be able to meet physical fitness test standards (70% in each area: Pushup, Sit-up, and 2 mile Run) Meet the your age standards http://www.apft-standards.com/
