2019 Scholarship Announcement.

We will award three scholarships this year. Two honor previous coaches; Eugene Williamon and Richard Madden. The third is the Over the Hill Gang Scholarship.

Each award is to the student's college, junior college, four year institution, or technical trade school of choice. The only stipulation is that the institution must be accredited. After each awardee provides proof of enrollment, an account will be established in the student's name. Installments of \$750 for each of the subsequent two semesters will be deposited with the institution.

Application Requirements – Please read carefully and comply with all "must" conditions

- 1. Applicants **must** be a graduating senior of the White Plains High School and **must** have an overall GPA of 2.5 or greater. If you have already, anticipate, or plan to accept a full scholarship (or "full ride"), please defer to the less fortunate. We reserve the right not to award if we discover a "full ride" has been accepted.
- 2. You **must** submit a copy of your high school transcript and you **must** provide your **certified** (by a school official) overall GPA in the line indicated below. Your transcript will be returned.
- 3. You **must** submit a <u>typewritten</u> list of your school activities, accomplishments and community involvement. It **must** be organized as follows: by grade to include a) clubs and extracurricular activities, b) community service and volunteer activities, and c) awards and honor societies and c). a brief biographical description of yourself.
- 3. You **must** submit a <u>typewritten</u> essay, in your own words, of 1000 words or less. It **must** be subdivided into the following sections: a) brief description your career objectives and goals; b) describe activities and courses that have prepared you for college or trade school, and d) discuss areas of concentration you plan to pursue in your college or trade school education.

Application Evaluation

Each application will be evaluated by the OTHG scholarship committee in the following three areas, with each weighted. Awards are based on highest scores in descending order.

Evaluation factors/ associated weights: 1. GPA – 35%; 2. Resume – 25% and 3. Essay – 40%.

Please note that <u>all</u> "**must**" conditions shall be complied with; failure to do so will result in disqualification.

Submittal Requirements

Enclose all items in a self-prepared pocket folder and give to Angela Forbus, counselor. The submitting deadline is no later than <u>3:00 p.m. on Friday, March 8th 2019</u>. No applications are accepted after this deadline.
