Insurance:

- 1. Speed on school campus is to be kept at or below 10 mph and drivers must operate their vehicles with due care and caution at all times.
- 2. Parking tag <u>MUST</u> be properly attached to vehicle at all times. Tag should hang in rear view mirror and be visible inside the vehicle when parked on campus.
- 3. Students must park in designated lots only and in a marked space.
- 4. The student driver understands that the local school administration retains the <u>right to revoke driving privileges</u> if it is deemed that the student is operating a vehicle in an unsafe manner, or continued operation of the vehicle would be a safety hazard to others, or for any other violation of this policy. This revocation can be anywhere from two weeks to permanent removal from parking lot.
- 5. Operating a motor vehicle is a privilege, not a right, and must be treated as such.
- 6. The student driver will operate his/her vehicle in accordance with state and local laws and will obey all common rules of safety, courtesy, and consideration of others.
- 7. The student driver also understands and agrees that the vehicle is subject to inspection and search by school officials in accordance with law and the Search and Seizure policy of the Board of Education.
- 8. The student driver understands and agrees to notify school office personnel if there is a change in vehicle type or tag number during the school year.
- 9. Once in the parking lot, students <u>must</u> report to the building immediately. Students should not return to the parking lot during the school day unless they have administrative approval. Leaving in their vehicle after being on school grounds constitutes a violation of the student code of conduct.
